Process for conducting mid-academic audit:

The departmental LMS coordinator distributes this sheet. Once completed, the report is sent to the Head of Department (HoD), who reviews it and provides oversight and recommendations. The Head of Department then sends the report to the Dean Academics with his comments. After review by the Dean, the report is sent to the office of the Director; the Director adds his comments and sends it back to the Dean Academics for necessary action. The concerned faculty member is then informed of the action to be taken, and the Head of Department is informed so that any deficiencies identified can be addressed and rectified.
