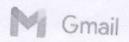

The Secretary extended a warm welcome to all Board members present at the commencement of the meeting, expressing appreciation for their participation and continued commitment to the Institute's development. Following the welcome address, the meeting proceeded with the discussion of agenda items, which were taken up in the order listed below:

27.1	Minutes of 26 th meeting of BoG held on January 31 2024, were unanimously approved by all the members. The action taken report on the decisions of 26 th meeting of BoG were presented & confirmed.	
27.2	Overview of Institute (Administration, Academics & TAP activities): There were quite a few new BoG members hence the Director of the Institute also the member secretary of the BoG presented an overview of the institute. She informed the BoG members about the courses being run in the institute.	
27.3	Approval of appointments of Faculty in the Department of Management (Affiliated to Jiwaji University, Gwalior) under Statutes 28(17) of the University Act, 1973: The Secretary presented the agenda for approval of the recommendation of the selection committee for the appointment of Assistant Professors in the Department of Management. Secretary also informed BoG about the process of selection of faculty members. The advertisement for these posts were published in the national newspaper, Times of India and local newspaper Nav Bharat on dated 01/11/2023. The following selection committee was constituted DCDC at Jiwaji University, Gwalior, the affiliating university for the MBA program: 1. Professor S. K. Singh – Chairperson, Selection Committee 2. Mr. Bhoopendra Kumar Jain – Member nominated by the Governing Body	



3. Professor Sanjeev Kumar Gupta - Subject Expert

4. Dr. Ravindra Babu - Subject Expert

A total of nine candidates were shortlisted for interviews, which were conducted on April 23, 2024. Based on the evaluation, the following three candidates were recommended by the selection committee for appointment as Assistant Professors:

- 1. Mr. Harshit Sinha (NET qualified)
- 2. Dr. Alka Sanyal (Ph.D.)

Mr. Adarsh Kumar (NET qualified)

The members of the Board of Governors deliberated on the alignment of the selection process and the qualifications of the recommended appointees with the institution's academic objectives and the specific needs of the Department of Management. It was noted that the appointments were conducted in strict accordance with the Institute's recruitment policies and approved by the respective selection committees, based on the established eligibility criteria.

27.4 Ratification of the following:

i) Budget of the institute:

The budget of the institute is scheduled for detailed discussion and review in the next Board of Governors meeting.

ii) Admission details of the session 2024-25:

The Secretary, presented a detailed report on the admissions for the current academic session (2024-25), highlighting the following key aspects:

- Total number of admission: 867
- Program-Wise Breakup: CSE: 312, IT: 128, CS (AIML): 116, CS (DS): 70, CS (IoT) 08, EC: 31, CE: 23, ME: 13, MBA: 121, MCA: 20, B.Tech. B.Tech. (LATERAL): 15

iii) Appointments and exits of faculty members:

The Board of Governors engaged in a discussion on the Institute's recruitment process and the initiatives aimed at retaining high-quality faculty. Several suggestions were put forward, including offering additional professional development opportunities to enhance faculty engagement and retention.

Professor Roopam Gupta proposed the development of innovative pedagogical



approaches to enhance the teaching-learning process. He further recommended involving industry professionals, particularly from the local industry, to teach students, noting that their proximity to the campus would enable them to dedicate more time to teaching and mentoring.

Professor Shekhar Verma proposed addressing faculty shortages in certain courses by creating larger classes to accommodate more students. He suggested that senior faculty members should be assigned to teach these larger classes, with a capacity of approximately 120 students, to maintain instructional quality. Additionally, Professor Verma recommended involving senior students, such as those in their final year of B.Tech. or pursuing M.Tech., in the teaching-learning process. He proposed offering remuneration to senior students for their contributions to academic work, a measure that would not only support faculty but also provide valuable teaching experience for the students. The Board members unanimously agreed to implement this approach in the teaching-learning process, particularly in situations where student admissions are high and there is a shortage of faculty. Professor Verma also emphasized the importance of monitoring and providing support to B.Tech. finalyear and M.Tech. students during their academic responsibilities. Following this, the Board Secretary advised the Dean of Academics to initiate the implementation of this practice in the current academic year, with the necessary measures to ensure effective engagement of senior students in teaching-learning activities.

iv) Annual Report of the institute for the Academic Year 2023-2024:

The Secretary presented the Annual Report for the Academic Year 2023-2024, offering a comprehensive overview of the institute's significant achievements across various domains, including academics, research, faculty development, and student engagement (Annexure 1).

vi) Report on e-governance of the institute for the Year 2023-2024:

The Secretary presented the E-Governance Report for the Year 2023-2024, providing a detailed overview of the significant advancements made in the institute's digital infrastructure and the transformative impact of various e-governance initiatives on both administrative efficiency and user experience (Annexure 2).
