Introduction:

Key Feedback Areas and Actions Taken

Area of Feedback	Summary of Faculty Feedback	Action Taken by ITM Gwalior
Classroom Infrastructure	Faculty raised concerns about classroom infrastructure and the need for better teaching aids.	ITM upgraded classroom facilities, installing projectors, smart boards, and audio-visual aids to enhance interactive learning. The physical environment in classrooms was also improved with better seating arrangements and lighting.
Need for Enhanced Research Opportunities	Faculty requested increased support for research activities, including access to better resources and funding.	The institution expanded its access to research databases and international journals. Research grants were introduced to encourage faculty members to undertake innovative research and attend conferences.
Professional Development and Skill Enhancement	There was a demand for more professional development programs to help faculty stay updated on the latest teaching methodologies and subject knowledge. Curriculum Development and Flexibility	Faculty recommended more flexibility in the curriculum to accommodate emerging industry trends and new technologies.	ITM review the curriculum to incorporate industry-relevant certificate courses, including subjects like Data Science, Artificial Intelligence, and Digital Marketing.

Student Engagement and Motivation	Faculty mentioned challenges in keeping students engaged, particularly with increasing distractions and lack of focus among students.	Workshops on student engagement strategies, including the use of technology in classrooms and project-based learning, were organized. Faculty were provided with new teaching tools and methods, such as flipped classrooms and blended learning, to boost student interest and participation.
Work-Life Balance and Faculty Well- being	Faculty indicated a need for better work-life balance and more consideration for their well-being.	ITM Gwalior introduced a more flexible teaching schedule and workload management system to reduce stress. Wellness programs, including yoga and mental health awareness sessions, were offered to support faculty members' wellbeing.
