

### Action taken Report Students Feedback for the Academic Year 2023-24

#### Overview:

This Action Taken Report outlines the steps taken by ITM, Gwalior, in response to the feedback received from students for the academic year 2023-24. The feedback covered key areas such as faculty performance, teaching methods, course content, infrastructure, and student support services. The actions listed below reflect the institute's commitment to enhancing the student learning experience based on these insights.

#### 1. Faculty Performance

- Feedback Summary: Faculty received positive ratings for subject knowledge, communication, and engagement. Suggestions included incorporating more real-world applications and providing more detailed feedback on assignments.
- · Action Taken:
  - Increased Real-World Applications: Faculty members have been encouraged to integrate more real-world case studies, examples, and industry-relevant applications into their teaching.
  - Assignment Feedback Enhancement: Faculties have been instructed to provide more detailed, constructive feedback on assignments, allowing students to better understand their strengths and areas for improvement.

#### 2. Teaching Methods

- Feedback Summary: Innovative teaching tools and group activities were praised, but students requested more hands-on learning opportunities.
- · Action Taken:
  - Introduction of More Hands-On Learning: Additional hands-on training sessions, workshops, and practical assignments have been integrated. Specific courses, particularly in technical areas, now include more lab-based activities and real-world simulations.

#### 3. Course Content

 Feedback Summary: The course content was rated highly, especially for being industryrelevant, though students emphasized the need for more practical projects and assignments.

#### 4. Infrastructure and Facilities

- Feedback Summary: Students were generally satisfied with classrooms and library resources, but requested upgrades to lab equipment and improvements to Wi-Fi connectivity.
- · Action Taken:
  - Upgrading Laboratory Equipment: Investments have been made to update lab equipment in several technical departments, ensuring students have access to the latest tools and technologies.
  - Wi-Fi Infrastructure Improvement: Campus-wide Wi-Fi has been enhanced to improve connectivity, particularly in previously problematic areas such as hostels and outdoor spaces.

### 5. Student Support and Resources

- Feedback Summary: Counseling and placement support received high ratings, but students requested more industry interaction and additional soft skills training.
- · Action Taken:
  - Enhanced Industry Interaction: A greater number of guest lectures, industry visits, and webinars have been organized to provide students with real-world exposure.
     Collaboration with industry leaders for internships and live projects has also been expanded.
  - Expanded Soft Skills Training: The institute has introduced more training sessions focused on communication, teamwork, and leadership development. These programs aim to further enhance students' employability and readiness for professional challenges.
