

#### Faculty Feedback Report Academic Session 2019-20

**Introduction:** The Faculty Feedback Report for the academic session 2019-20 at ITM Gwalior aims to highlight the experiences, observations, and suggestions provided by the faculty. The feedback plays a crucial role in understanding areas of improvement in teaching methodologies, curriculum development, infrastructure, and overall academic support.

- 1. Curriculum Effectiveness: Faculty feedback indicated general satisfaction with the curriculum structure. Many faculty members appreciated the curriculum's alignment with industry needs, but they suggested periodic reviews to include emerging technologies.
- 2. Teaching Resources and Infrastructure: While the faculty appreciated the available teaching resources, such as classrooms, labs, and libraries, there were suggestions for upgrades in specific areas. Some faculty members emphasized the need for more modern lab equipment and better access to digital libraries, especially for research purposes.
- **3. Research and Development Support:** Several faculty members mentioned the need for greater institutional support in their research activities. They suggested for allocate more funding for research projects and provide faculty with opportunities to attend national and international conferences. Increased collaboration with industries for research partnerships and consultancy projects was also proposed.
- 4. Faculty Development Programs (FDPs): Faculty highlighted the importance of continuous professional development through workshops, FDPs, and certifications. While some faculty members participated in skill enhancement programs during the academic session, they suggested organizing more in-house training sessions focused on the latest teaching methodologies, subject-specific advancements, and technological tools for education.
- **5. Student Engagement and Academic Performance:** The faculty reported positive engagement with students, noting that the majority of students were motivated and performed well academically. However, some faculty members suggested introducing more active learning techniques and collaborative projects to keep students engaged, especially in larger classrooms. Some recommended increasing the number of tutorials and practical sessions to help students grasp complex concepts.
- **6. Examination and Evaluation System:** Faculties were generally satisfied with the current examination and evaluation processes. However, some suggested to incorporating more continuous assessments, such as quizzes, presentations, and projects, to ensure that students are evaluated holistically throughout the semester.
