

# Faculty Feedback Report Academic Session 2021-22

#### Introduction:

The Faculty Feedback Report for the academic session 2021-22 at ITM Gwalior reflects the faculty's observations and suggestions regarding the curriculum, infrastructure, administrative support, research opportunities, and other aspects of academic life. This feedback provides insights into areas requiring attention and improvement, supporting the institution's commitment to creating an effective learning environment.

### 1. Curriculum Effectiveness:

Faculty members expressed overall satisfaction with the curriculum structure, particularly its alignment with industry requirements. They highlighted the need for more frequent curriculum updates to incorporate advancements in areas. Faculty also recommended adding more interdisciplinary courses and promoting student-led projects to enhance problem-solving skills.

#### 2. Infrastructure and Classroom Facilities:

While faculty members appreciated the available facilities, including well-maintained labs and libraries, some recommended upgrading classroom technologies. There was a request for enhanced the technological infrastructure, including more robust IT support and better access to teaching tools.

## 3. Faculty Development Programs and Trainings

Most of the faculty members have appreciated the faculty development program and trainings conducted at ITM but some faculty members expressed the need for more opportunities to engage in the professional development and up skilling also.

## 4. Industry and Academic Collaborations:

Faculty members highlighted the importance of improving collaboration with industries and academic institutions to enhance research, internships, and student exposure. Suggestions included integrating industry projects into the curriculum and organizing regular guest lectures by industry experts to provide students with practical insights and enhance their employability.

# 5. Technology and Digital Resources:

The faculty appreciated the institution's efforts in providing technology support, especially in transitioning to hybrid learning post-pandemic. However, they suggested expanding access to digital

resources such as e-books, academic databases, and research journals. Enhanced training sessions on emerging digital tools for both teaching and research were also recommended.

#### 6. Recognition and Rewards System:

The faculty expressed satisfaction with the existing recognition system for teaching excellence but suggested expanding the scope to include rewards for research publications, conference presentations, and innovative teaching practices. A more transparent system for recognizing academic contributions was recommended to boost motivation and faculty engagement.

# 7. Research and Development Support:

Faculty members acknowledged the support provided for research but called for increased funding and access to research infrastructure. They suggested some more opportunities for faculty development programs focusing on advanced research skills. Additionally, faculty recommended encouraging more collaboration with industries for consultancy projects and research partnerships.

#### Conclusion:

The faculty feedback for the academic year 2021-22 emphasizes the need for continued improvements in curriculum innovation, infrastructure upgrades, and research support. ITM Gwalior remains committed to addressing these suggestions and creating a dynamic academic environment conducive to both teaching and research excellence.
