

Faculty Feedback Report Academic Session 2022-23

Introduction:

The Faculty Feedback Report for the academic session 2022-23 at ITM Gwalior highlights faculty experiences and suggestions across key areas such as curriculum development, infrastructure, administrative support, and research opportunities. The insights gathered from faculty feedback are vital for driving institutional improvements and enhancing the academic environment.

1. Curriculum Effectiveness:

Faculty members were largely satisfied with the curriculum of both the universities; RGPV Bhopal and Jiwaji University Gwalior, noting its relevance to both academia and industry. There was a request for more comprehensive professional development programs to enhance teaching skills and academic knowledge

2. Infrastructure and Classroom Facilities:

The faculty appreciated the overall infrastructure, particularly the availability of labs and libraries. Faculty suggested the need for advanced digital tools and better technological support for both teaching and research

3. Administrative Support and Workload Distribution:

Faculty feedback indicated general satisfaction with the administrative support, but some suggested streamlining certain administrative processes to reduce delays in approvals and paperwork. There were some concerns about maintaining a healthy work-life balance amidst increasing academic and administrative

4. Industry and Academic Collaborations:

Faculty reported positive experiences with student engagement and teaching outcomes. However, they suggested increasing collaborations with industries and academic institutions to enhance research, internships, and placement opportunities. The integration of industry-led projects and workshops within the curriculum was proposed to provide students with more hands-on experience.

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5. Technology and Digital Resources:

Faculty acknowledged the institution's efforts in integrating digital platforms for teaching, particularly in light of post-pandemic needs. However, they expressed the need for enhanced access to digital resources, such as academic journals, e-books, and databases, to support both teaching and research initiatives. Additional training for faculty on new digital tools was also recommended.

6. Recognition and Rewards System:

Faculty appreciated the existing recognition system for teaching excellence but recommended that it be expanded to recognize contributions in research, publications, and innovative pedagogical methods. A transparent system for acknowledging these contributions would motivate faculty members to pursue academic excellence more actively.

7. Research and Development Support:

There was positive feedback regarding the institutional support for research, but faculty members suggested an increase in research funding and the introduction of more faculty development programs focused on research methodologies. Feedback suggested a need for improved collaboration between departments to enhance academic and research synergies.

Conclusion:

The faculty feedback for the academic year 2022-23 highlights areas of strength, such as curriculum relevance and administrative support, while also identifying opportunities for improvement, particularly in infrastructure upgrades, research support, and industry collaborations. The institution is committed to addressing these suggestions to foster a supportive and progressive academic environment at ITM Gwalior.
