

Students Feedback Report for the Academic Year 2023-24

Overview:

This report summarizes the feedback collected from students for the academic year 2023-24. 1. Faculty Performance

- Overall Rating: Very Good
- Key Strengths:
 - o Subject Knowledge: Faculty members are highly knowledgeable, keeping the content relevant and updated with industry standards.
 - Clarity and Communication: Students appreciated the clarity in explanations and the ability of faculty to break down complex topics into easily understandable concepts.
 - o Interactive Engagement: Faculty promoted an engaging learning environment by encouraging questions, discussions, and in-class participation.
 - Mentorship: Faculties were approachable outside classroom hours, offering guidance and mentorship.

Areas for Improvement:

- o Real-World Applications: Students suggested that more industry-relevant examples and real-world applications could be integrated into the learning materials.
- o Assignment Feedback: Some students requested more detailed feedback on assignments and assessments to help track their progress and areas for improvement.

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2. Teaching Methods

- Overall Rating: Good
- Key Strengths:
 - Teaching Tools: Faculty effectively utilized multimedia, presentations, and interactive tools to enhance the learning experience.
 - Group Activities: Students responded positively to group discussions, presentations, and collaborative projects, which helped in peer learning.
- · Areas for Improvement:
 - Hands-On Learning: More hands-on sessions and practical training were requested, particularly in courses that involve technical skills.

3. Course Content

- · Overall Rating: Very Good
- · Key Strengths:
 - Industry-Relevant Content: The course content has been praised for being aligned with current trends and the needs of the industry.
 - Electives and Specializations: Students appreciated the range of electives and specialization options available, which allowed them to tailor their learning to their career goals.
- Areas for Improvement:
 - Practical Focus: While the theoretical foundation is strong, students emphasized the need for greater emphasis on practical projects and industry-oriented assignments.

4. Infrastructure and Facilities

- Overall Rating: Good
- Key Strengths:
 - Classroom and Learning Spaces: Students found the classrooms and learning environments to be well-equipped and conducive to learning.
 - o Library Resources: The availability of a vast range of academic resources, including e-books and online journals, was highly appreciated.
- Areas for Improvement:
 - Lab Equipment: Some students noted that certain laboratories, particularly in technical courses, require updated equipment and tools to better support handson learning.

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 Campus Wi-Fi: Wi-Fi connectivity is a concern for some students, particularly in areas like open spaces.

5. Student Support and Resources

- Overall Rating: Very Good
- · Key Strengths:
 - Counseling and Guidance: The counseling services and career guidance provided by the institute were positively rated, helping students with both academic and personal challenges.
 - Placement Support: Students expressed satisfaction with the placement support, especially in terms of internship opportunities and pre-placement training sessions.
- · Areas for Improvement:
 - Industry Interaction: More frequent industry interactions, guest lectures, and industrial visits were requested to provide students with greater exposure to real-world challenges.
 - Soft Skills Training: Additional sessions focusing on soft skills, particularly communication and leadership development, were suggested by some students.

Summary of Findings:

The feedback for the academic year 2023-24 reflects a positive student experience overall at ITM, Gwalior. Faculty performance, course content, and student support services received high ratings, with students particularly valuing the interactive teaching methods and industry relevance of the curriculum. However, there is room for improvement in infrastructure, particularly in terms of lab equipment and campus-wide internet connectivity. There is also a demand for increased practical learning opportunities and stronger industry engagement.


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
