Report on the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) Conducted by the Various Departments: Year 2023-24

The Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) for the session 2023-24 were conducted by the various departments of the Institute of Technology & Management (ITM). This audit aimed to systematically review and evaluate the academic processes, administrative functions, and overall quality initiatives across all departments. The key findings, observations, and summaries from this comprehensive exercise are presented below.

Audit Coverage:

- Academic: Curriculum delivery, Course Outcomes (CO) and Program Outcomes (PO)
 attainment, teaching-learning processes, internal assessments, co-curricular and extra curricular activities; department academic calendar adhered to.
- Faculty: Adoption of innovative teaching methods, participation in FDPs, research and publications, mentorship activities; use of teaching aids including PPTs, videos, and simulations.
- Administrative: Documentation of academic records, examination processes, internal policies, resource utilization, compliance with statutory requirements, and LMS/MIS used for tracking.
- Student Support Services: Career counseling, placement support, remedial coaching, project guidance, grievance redressal, and student engagement in clubs, projects, and competitions.

Key Observations:

- Curriculum delivery well-structured; CO-PO mapping clear; theory, practical/lab sessions documented digitally via LMS.
- Faculty engaged in blended teaching; teaching aids and LMS/MIS effectively used.
- Distribution of ABCA activities consistent across semester; student participation in project work and seminars high.
- Administrative processes compliant; minor delays in procurement documentation.
- Students actively involved in co-curricular activities; infrastructure in departments upgraded for labs and classrooms.
- Student feedback collected and analyzed; actions implemented in tutorials, lab sessions, and mentorship.

Recommendations:

- Strengthen documentation of practical sessions and lab records on LMS.
- Conduct faculty workshops especially for newly joined faculty members in the various departments.
- Continue upgrading departmental infrastructure and digital resources.

Follow-up Actions Taken:

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- Refresher workshops for faculty on activity-based and experiential learning conducted.
- Digital tracking of lab sessions, project progress, and ABCA activities implemented via LMS/MIS.
- Mentorship sessions, remedial coaching, and student guidance programs enhanced.
- Departmental seminars, research activities, and co-curricular events successfully organized.

Seminar / **Research:** Faculty and students participated in national/international seminars; research publications submitted and funded proposals initiated.

Strength, Weakness, Opportunities & Challenges (SWOC):

- Strengths: Competent faculty, modern infrastructure, structured ABCA, active student engagement. Enhanced mentorship programs and student support, particularly for project-based learning.
- Weaknesses: Very less number of governments funded research projects.
- Opportunities: Research funding, international collaborations, interdisciplinary projects.
- Challenges: Rapid technological changes, bridging skill gaps.

Best Practices: Activity-Based Learning integrated; structured mentorship and digital monitoring via LMS/MIS.

Future Plan: Strengthen industry tie-ups, expand digital resources and interdisciplinary projects.






