Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan is the mission started by the Government of India on 13th May 2020, towards making India Self-reliant. The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi announced an economic package of INR 20 lakh crores, equivalent to 10% of India's GDP to fight COVID-19 pandemic in India. The Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitaraman announced the details of the measures provided under the Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan through five press conferences. These measures are provided to different sectors and areas to cover and help everyone affected by the pandemic. The measures were announced keeping in mind the five pillars of Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan.



#### The five pillars of Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan

- 1. Economy That brings quantum jump rather than incremental change.
- 2. Infrastructure To become the identity of modern India.
- 3. Systems Technology-driven systems
- Demography India's strength is its demography, and it is the source of energy for selfreliant India.
- 5. Demand Full utilisation of the power of demand & supply

#### Schemes launched under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan

- Agriculture Infrastructure Fund project Financing facility of Rs. 1,00,000 crore will be provided for funding Agriculture Infrastructure Projects at farm-gate
- Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund Aim to support private investment in Dairy Processing, value addition and cattle feed infrastructure. An Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund of Rs. 15,000 crore will be set up.
- Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana For integrated, sustainable, inclusive development of marine and inland fisheries. Cage Culture, Seaweed farming, Ornamental Fisheries as well as New Fishing Vessels, Traceability, Laboratory Network etc. will be key activities. Employment to over 55 lakh persons.
- 4. Technology Development Fund Scheme The Scheme encourages participation of public/private industries, especially MSMEs and start-ups, so as to create an ecosystem for enhancing cutting edge technology capability in the defence sector. The scheme will be limited to development of technologies or prototypes of products having potential use for National Defence.
- Defence production & export promotion policy To make India amongst the leading countries of the world in Defence sector, including Aerospace and Naval Shipbuilding sectors, from design to production, with active participation of public and private sector.
- Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana Rs. 1.70 Lakh Crore relief package under (PMGKY) for the poor to help them fight the battle against Corona Virus. Insurance cover of Rs 50 Lakh per health worker. 80 crore poor people given benefit of 5 kg wheat or rice per person, 1 kg pulses for each household for 3 months.
  - Front-loaded Rs 2,000 paid to farmers under existing PM-KISAN to benefit 8.7 crore farmers. Building and Construction Workers Welfare Fund allowed to be used to provide relief to workers.
- Incentive Scheme for Promoting Domestic Manufacturing of Medical Devices The Scheme proposes a financial incentive to boost domestic manufacturing and attract large investments in the Medical Device Sector.




## **Beyond Classroom**


